Day 1: Mercedes Benz Museum

Upon arrival meet your private transfer at the airport and transfer to your accommodation. Check – in to your accommodation and rest of the day at leisure. Stuttgart, capital of southwest Germany's Baden-Württemberg state, is known as a manufacturing hub. Mercedes-Benz and Porsche have headquarters and museums here. The city is filled with greenspaces, which wrap around its center. Popular parks include the Schlossgarten, Rosensteinpark and Killesbergpark. Wilhelma, one of the largest zoos and botanical gardens in Europe, is just northeast of Rosenstein Castle.

You have a chance to visit wonderful Mercedes-Benz Museum with its exhibits relating to the development of the automobile. The star attractions, though, are the more than 160 vehicles. The nearby Untertürkheim diesel engine factory is also open for tours, and the Porsche Museum, with its exquisite collection of more than 300 restored vehicles, is also worth a visit. Overnight in Stuttgart.



Day 2: Europa Park

Stuttgart city tour is an entertaining and informative tour & cover historic heart of city. This tour through time covers the founding of the city in 950 all the way through the present day. The Staatsgalerie Stuttgart (the State Gallery) is home to one of the finest art collections in Germany and is one of the country's most visited museums. Best known for its superlative collection of 20th-century paintings, the museum also boasts impressive collections of German Renaissance art as well as Dutch and Italian Masters from the 14th to 19th centuries. The expansive Schlossplatz is very much the focal point for visitors and locals alike. On the northwest side of the square is the 19th-century Königsbau with its colonnade and shopping arcade, and to the southwest, on higher ground, the Kleiner Schlossplatz with its many boutique shops. The impressive structure houses the Württemberg Landesmuseum with its fine collection of medieval art, musical instruments, watches and clocks, as well as the Württemberg crown jewels. Killesberg Park is a lovely 123-acre open space that's fun to explore. Many of the structures seen today date back to its pre-war opening and are still used for flower shows and other events. One of the most popular original features is the Killesberg Railway, a narrow-gauge.

Day 3: Switzerland

After breakfast your journey towards Lucerne, is a compact city in Switzerland known for its preserved medieval architecture, sits amid snowcapped mountains on Lake Lucerne. Its colorful Altstadt is bordered on the north by 870m Museggmauer, a 14-century rampart. The covered Kapellbrücke (Chapel Bridge), built in 1333, links the Aldstadt to the Reuss River's right bank.

Overnight in Switzerland.

Day 4: Jungfraujoch a mountain excursion

Interlaken tour, a charming city nestled between two lakes and surrounded by the splendid Bernese Oberland Mountains. Perhaps begin your tour at Interlaken's castle, once an Augustinian monastery. Explore the town square and admire the many pretty buildings for which Interlaken is famous. Head on to the town's grand train station to admire its traditional Swiss Alpine façade, then stroll onward across the Aare River and gaze out over the mighty waterway. Learn the reasons behind the river's odd coloration and hear tales of the Jungfrau, the Mönch and the Eiger — Interlaken's local mountain peaks. Take a stroll up to the Hohbühl pavilion, a romantic hilltop spot popular among Interlaken's young lovers. Enjoy panoramic views over Lake Thun and Lake Brienz, and marvel at the snow-capped peaks of the Swiss Alps looming large in the distance. During your tour, gain insight into what makes Interlaken so special. Hear the legend of the "Hardermannli," discover the secrets of the town's flag and learn of the best spots to enjoy traditional Swiss beer, chocolate and cuisine.

You have chance to visit Jungfraujoch a mountain excursion.

Overnight in Lucerne.

Day 5: Titlis, Engelberg a mountain excursion

Lucerne tour, where you will have an opportunity to visit the Lion Monument and the Kapell Brucke wooden bridge. Free time to shop for famous Swiss watches, knives and chocolates. Visit several top Lucerne attractions including the famous the wooden Chapel Bridge (Kapellbrücke), a symbol of Lucerne, spanning the Reuss River. Built in the 14th century, it's Europe's oldest covered wooden bridge and the oldest surviving truss bridge in the world. On one side of the bridge you'll see the Water Tower, a site that served as a dungeon during the Middle Ages.

Amble hidden roads and popular public squares full of locals for a glimpse of daily local life in Lucerne. Learn about Switzerland's Jesuit and Protestant religious heritage at historical Jesuit Church, and then witness the pristine acoustics in the concert hall of the Culture and Congress Centre (known simply as the KKL). Your route also includes a sight of the imposing Musegg Wall, that marks the remains of Lucerne's medieval ramparts. enjoy a cruise on Lake Lucerne. Be captivated by the magnificent scenery, as you soak in the beauty and grandeur of the Alps. You have chance to visit Titlis, Engelberg a mountain excursion.

Overnight in Lucerne.



Day 6: Rhine Falls with boat Ticket

After breakfast proceed towards Zurich, The city of Zurich, a global center for banking and finance, lies at the north end of Lake Zurich in northern Switzerland. The picturesque lanes of the central Altstadt (Old Town), on either side of the Limmat River, reflect its pre-medieval history. Waterfront promenades like the Limmatquai follow the river toward the 17th-century Rathaus (town hall).

You can spend some time shopping at Bahnhofstrasse, the most popular shopping avenue of Switzerland, which is also famous for its luxury stores and cafés. Later, we drive you to Schaffhausen to view from lift side the magnificent Rhine Falls – the largest waterfall in Europe. Overnight in Lucerne.



Day 7: Eiffel Tower (2nd Level) & Paris Cruise

After breakfast your journey towards Paris France's capital, is a major European city and a global center for art, fashion, gastronomy and culture. Its 19th-century cityscape is crisscrossed by wide boulevards and the River Seine. Beyond such landmarks as the Eiffel Tower and the 12th-century, Gothic Notre-Dame cathedral, the city is known for its cafe culture and designer boutiques along the Rue du Faubourg Saint-Honoré.

Checkin Paris Accommodation. In evening you have chance to enjoy a breathtaking view of Paris from the top of Eiffel Tower (2nd Level), Paris cruise, a grand night-out at the world-famous music and dance extravaganza – The Lido Show.

Day 8: Disneyland Paris

Paris tour, an exhilarating city tour, includes many of the best-loved Parisian sights – the Alexander Bridge, the Arc de Triomphe, Concorde Square, the Opera House, the Invalides, Champs de Elysees and many more. Enjoy the sights of Paris on a city tour. You also have some free time to shop for perfumes and souvenirs. Afternoon you have a chance to enjoy Disneyland Paris.

Day 9: Journey towards Louver Museum

Time-slot bookings are compulsory, including for free-admission visitors. Mask wearing is recommended while inside the museum. The museum is open daily except Tuesdays.

Last entry 1 hour before closure. Visitors will be asked to vacate the exhibition rooms 30 minutes before closure. The Pyramid is the main entrance to the museum. At peak times, you can access the museum via the Carrousel and Porte des Lions entrances. Explore the former palace of the kings of France – now the largest museum in the world covering almost 10,000 years of history! The palace is divided into three wings: Richelieu, Sully and Denon. Take your pick!

This is the most famous portrait in the world. It shows Lisa Gherardini, wife of the Florentine silk merchant Francesco del Giocondo – hence her Italian name La Gioconda and her French name La Joconde. Painted against a distant landscape, she stares out at us with her famously enigmatic smile...but another aspect of the painting that makes it so special is Leonardo da Vinci's sfumato technique, based on the use of glazes to create a 'smoky' effect with subtle contours and contrasts. Leonardo captured the sitter turning towards the viewer in a natural movement that brings the painting to life.

Overnight in Paris.
